Mansfield - Charles Scott, 58, went home to be with the Lord, Tuesday, March 1, 2016, after an extended illness.

Charles was born May 2, 1957, in Mansfield, OH, to the late Albert and Estella Lee- Scott. Charles was a lifelong resident of Mansfield. He was a member of the 1976 graduating class of Mansfield Senior High School and earned his B.S. at Wilberforce University in 2006.
