MANSFIELD — Joycelyn Virginia (Hall) Morr, 95, of Mansfield, died peacefully in her sleep Saturday, March 22, 2025, at home.

She was born Aug. 5, 1929, in Mansfield, daughter of the now-deceased Virginia (Hall) Thompson and Carl Groppe, and resided in Mansfield her entire life.

Joycelyn attended Mansfield City Schools and graduated from Mansfield High School in 1947. She worked as a secretary at Westinghouse, as a switchboard operator for doctors, and as a clerical worker at Ritters office supply store.

She married Harry W. Morr on Sept. 21, 1946, in Covington, Ky., and they enjoyed more than 67 years of marriage prior to his passing on July 12, 2014.

Joycelyn and her husband were baptized as Jehovah's Witnesses on July 28, 1949.

She enjoyed sharing her Bible-based beliefs with others, especially by writing letters with encouraging Bible verses — six days a week in recent years. She also enjoyed gathering with fellow believers and attending congregation meetings, mostly through a videoconference provision after 2019. Her

perseverance in the face of advanced age and illness was inspiring to many.

Though quiet, Joycelyn was witty and very hospitable. She very much loved her family members and enjoyed following their spiritual pursuits and adventures from afar. She was appreciative, dependable and loyal.
